TVA in Alabama

- TVA covers 8,979 square miles of Alabama with 6,826 miles of watershed management. Local power companies (LPCs) distribute TVA in 17 Alabama counties.
- TVA sold 18.6 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity to 17 municipalities and 8 co-ops in Alabama.
- TVA provided 7.84 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity to 510,000 households through LPCs in Alabama.
- TVA served 9.79 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity to 102,000 Commercial and Industrial Customers through LPCs.
- TVA generated \$1.6 billion in power revenue in Alabama in 2019. That comprises 14.1% of TVA's total operating revenue.
- In Alabama, TVA operates three hydroelectric dams (Guntersville, Wheeler and Wilson), one nuclear power plant (Browns Ferry) and one natural gas-fueled combustion turbine site (Colbert), with a combined generating capacity of more than 4,870 megawatts.
- TVA operates two solar facilities in Alabama—a 23-kilowatt site at the Huntsville Botanical Gardens and a 36-kilowatt site at the Florence wastewater treatment facility.
